1. Purpose of the report

- 1.1 To invite the Council to note the current status of the Council's outstanding Community Issues.

2. Background

- 2.1 The group is being retitled to include the possibility for footpath improvements to be considered and actioned. The group henceforth will be called Local Highways & Footpath Improvement Group (LHFIG). An increased budget has been allocated by WC, consequently the 22/23 budget available for allocating to new projects is £39,315.41.

7-19-9	Speeding along Grange Lane	Nothing further to report
7-21-11	A broken corner kerb and minor road repair at junction of C67E and lane leading to Wessex Water pumping Station in Milbourne	Will be the subject of a conversation with the new local Highways Officer Rebecca Chivers. The repair may be incorporated into the Milbourne safety refuge project
7-22-1	Request to introduce a speed restriction of 30mph along the B4014 Filands	The issue will also be incorporated into the holistic approach to improving highway and pedestrian safety along the B4014 Filands. Item CLOSED but will be incorporated into highway improvements as a result of the residential developments along Filands.
Not allocated yet	Highway improvements on the A429 at Corston to provide additional warning to motorists of the severity of the bend and to prevent vehicles crashing through the fence on the other side of the road	A brief explanation of the issues and possible solutions was provided to members.
