1. Purpose of the report

- 1.1 To invite the Council to note the current status of the Council's outstanding Community Issues.

2. Background

- 2.1 A new increased budget of £26,150 for 2022/23, to recognise the addition of footpath activity to the previous highway work, together with an underspend on the 2021/22 budget of £31,680 has resulted in available funds of £57,830 for the group. Given the anticipated project funding commitments, with the contributions from parishes, the available funding for new projects is £29,675.

7-21-11	A broken corner kerb and minor road repair at junction of C67E and lane leading to Wessex Water pumping Station in Milbourne	Will be the subject of a conversation with the new local Highways Officer Rebecca Chivers. The repair may be incorporated into the Milbourne safety refuge project. Nothing further to report.
7-22-6	Corston - A429 junction with Mill Lane	Road safety issue at the sharp bend caused by excessive vehicle speeds - Priority 2 project.
