- 1. Purpose of the report
- 1.1 To invite the Council to note the current status of the Council's outstanding Community Issues.

## 2. Budget

2.1 An increased budget of £26,150 for 2022/23, to recognise the addition of footpath activity to the previous highway work, was agreed by WC. Together with an underspend on the 2021/22 budget of £31,680, has resulted in available funds of £69,095, slightly more than previously reported, because a number of projects have been withdrawn from the projects' list. Given the anticipated active project funding commitments, together with the contributions from parishes, the available funding for new projects is £26,545.

7-21-11	A broken corner kerb and minor road repair at junction of C67E and lane leading to Wessex Water pumping Station in Milbourne	Completed during extension of the Milbourne pedestrian footway.
7-22-6	Corston - A429 junction with Mill Lane	Removed from the LHFIG list as WC has agreed to connect a Parish Council funded SID device to lighting post #30 - installation anticipated imminently.
7-22-8	Request to move 30mph restriction further east towards Lea	Traffic survey (metro count) needed to check speeds for vehicles travelling east down the hill from Malmesbury, solution may be the installation of a possible SID.
7-22-17	Southside Close, Corston - request for a formal pedestrian crossing	Site meeting to be arranged with Elizabeth Threlfall, Steve Hind and Roger Budgen to discuss options for improved pedestrian safety.
