Plaques for Queens' Jubilee Trees

1. Purpose of the report

- 1.1 To invite council to approve the purchase of three plaques to mark the planting of the six trees in the parish as part of the Queen's Green Canopy

2. Background

- 2.1 Following the planting of the six commemorative trees, a number of suggestions have been received from residents that plaques should be placed by each pair of trees to mark the reason for planting them. The trees were planted in the Chippenham Road play ground and at the entrance to Milbourne Park and Monk's Park, Milbourne.

- 2.2 The proposed wording for the plaques is shown in the Appendix to the report.

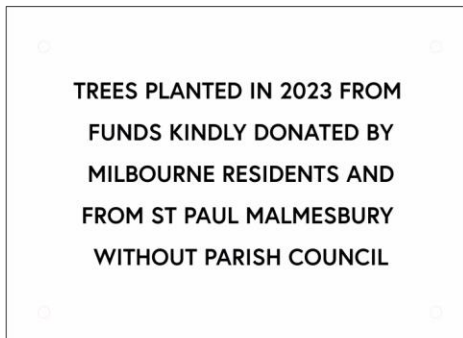

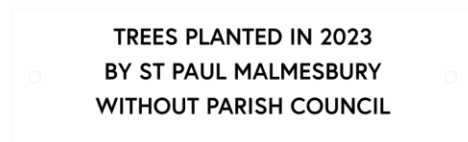
